

## **Crowe Morgan 2013 Calendar**

### **Photographic Competition for all students Aged 11 – 18 years**

**Do you like taking photographs?**

**Do you aspire to have your artistic and photographic talent recognised?**

**Then we want to hear from you!**

Each year Crowe Morgan produces a desktop calendar (CD Holder format) which is distributed to clients and other contacts (currently approximately 750 calendars are circulated, of which 50% go off Island).

For the 2012 calendar, Crowe Morgan ran its first ever photographic competition for young Isle of Man residents and over 150 entries were received. The theme of the calendar was “Spirit of the Isle of Man” and as can be observed from the attached copy the end result really captures this. Due to the success of the calendar we have decided to run a further competition for our 2013 calendar.

The theme of the 2013 calendar is “Sporting Island” which ties in very well with London hosting the Olympics! Attached is a list, although not exhaustive, of events that are happening throughout 2012 until the deadline of the competition, Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2012.

We are therefore inviting all schools and colleges to encourage their students aged 11 – 18 years to enter photographs for inclusion in our 2013 calendars and build on the success of the 2012 calendar.

## Crowe Morgan 2013 Calendar Competition Criteria

- The competition is open to all young people aged 11 – 18 years in schools in the Isle of Man
- The Theme of the Calendars is “**Sporting Island**”
- We would like striking professional quality photographs to reflect our sporting nation. The photographs do not necessarily have to be taken on the Isle of Man, but they must have a Manx theme, eg Mark Cavendish at the Tour de France.
- Entries must be submitted by **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2012**, but may be entered any time before the closing date.
- Photographs must be in landscape format. Photographs submitted in portrait format will not be entered into the competition.
- Entries must be submitted in high resolution (a minimum of 225dpi, but 300dpi is preferred) digital format (Tiff, jpeg or psd), either by email or on a disc as per address details on the entry form.
- Each photograph must have a title which captures the image of the photograph.
- Each photograph must have an entry form attached, and you must ensure that all details are fully completed, as the name, age and title of the photograph as it appears on the form is what will appear on the calendar, should your photograph win.
- Photographs will be judged anonymously.
- More than one photograph may be submitted by each student.
- The photographs will be judged in October at a date to be confirmed.

- Winners will be contacted as soon as possible after final judging has taken place and invited to attend a presentation event in November (date, time and venue to be confirmed).
- The winners will each receive a prize (details to be confirmed), a framed copy of their photograph, a copy of the calendar, and a certificate to record their achievement.
- The judging panel will be made up from the following:

  - Mike Wade (Isle of Man Newspapers photographer)
  - John Moss (Manx Radio)
  - Antony Hamilton (President, Isle of Man Photographic Society)
  - Ken Callister (Youth Service)
- The judging panel's decisions are final and no discussions will be entered into.
- Crowe Morgan will own the copyright for the winning photographs.
- Crowe Morgan to have the right to use any photograph submitted for future publicity material including their website. In these cases the photographer will be acknowledged. Crowe Morgan will not own the copyright in these instances – copyright remains with the entrant.
